Windsor Newton tube paints:

Basic Colors:

Paper: Arches 140 lb. cold press 22"x30" (will be broken down to smaller sizes)

Also,

Paper towels, half a credit card, razor blade, toothpicks, clean flat sponge, three white water containers (frosting cans work best), water spray bottle, good quality masking tape, sample size baby shampoo, 0.5mm mechanical pencil, notepaper, and carrying case.

Windsor-Newton watercolors are the best but are expensive. Other brands are available that are less expensive and may be substituted. As with all art supplies, less expensive paints will have fillers and will not produce the vibrancy of pure Windsor-Newton colors. With paints, paper and brushes, I strongly recommend using the best you can afford. The difference in quality is about the same as the difference between fun and frustration.
